



Bumbleberry Cowl

This cowl shows off a variety of stitches and colors, but so easy to knit on the Double Knit Loom.



KNITTING LOOM: Double Knit Loom

YARN: Caron Cakes Self Stripping worsted, 80% Acrylic and 20% Wool, 383 yes per skein. Color used is Bumbleberry (4 different shades of purple and lilac). Worked in 2 stitch patterns and the colors take care of themselves

STITCHES: Stockinette and rib

NOTIONS: Knit hook and crochet hook

SIZE: 9" high

GAUGE: Approx 4 rows=1"

ABBREVIATIONS

approx=approximately

rib=rib stitch

S=stockinette stitch or knit

st(sts)=stitch(es)

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on all 52 pegs with basic S stitch working in the round in double knit. Lay anchor yarn around the loom between the 2 looms. Allow the ends to drop below the knit.

Rounds 1-18: S

Rounds 19: Rib

Rounds 20: S

Rounds 21-38: Rib

Bind off by moving the inner loom loops to outer loom. The inner loom will be empty and 2 loops will be on each peg on outer loom. Lift bottom loop over the top loop, so that there is just one loop on each peg on outer loom. Pull down on the knit to secure the loops. Crochet the loops off in chain fashion (loosely). Tie off last loop. Weave in ends.
