



Double Knit Hat with Brim

Cozy cap with ribbing edge and soft stockinette. The shape makes this a great fitting hat that you'll love to wear. Try it with many different #5 yarns.



KNITTING LOOM: Double Knit Loom.

YARN: Sample uses Lion Brand Scarfie. 78% Acrylic and 22% Wool, 312 yds per skein, #5 bulky, machine washable and lay flat to dry, (1) skein

STITCHES: Rib and stockinette

NOTIONS: Knit hook, crochet hook

GAUGE: 4 rows=1"

SIZE: Adult

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast On all 52 pegs in stockinette stitch, using both inner and outer looms. Prepare to work double knit in round.

Rounds 1 - 8: Change to rib stitch. Work in rib stitch for 8 rounds. This is the brim of the hat.

Round 9: Change to stockinette stitch.

Repeat row 9 until knit is 8-9" long from the cast on row.

When transitioning from rib to stockinette, you will find that one consecutive wrap is needed at the beginning of the next round. This puts your new round in the correct position for the stockinette stitch.

Bind off top of hat with gather bind off. Hat is complete.
