



Double Knit Hat (without Brim)

A super easy hat to knit on the Double Knit Loom. Stockinette stitch is used throughout with no brim or border. Create a little 'slouch' effect with extra length.



KNITTING LOOM: Double Knit Loom

YARN: Sample uses Red Heart Treasure yarn, (1) skein. 78% Acrylic and 22% Wool, 312 yds per skein, #5 bulky, machine washable and lay flat to dry, (1) skein.

STITCHES: Stockinette

NOTIONS: Knit hook, crochet hook

GAUGE: 4 rows=1"

SIZE: Adult

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast On all 52 pegs on both inner and outer loom, in stockinette stitch. Prepare to work double knit in the round. Lay anchor yarn over the stitches and allow it to drop below the loom.

Round 1: Work in stockinette stitch, starting on beginning peg. This will just be a continuation of the cast on process. No additional anchor yarns are needed.

Repeat Row 1, until knit is approximately 9" in length.

Bind off with Gather bind off.

If a pom-pom is desired, it looks great with this hat.
