



Simple Stripe Set

LOOM: 'Rotating' Double Knit Loom, with 60 Peg Loom Topper

YARN: Sample knit with Caron Simply Soft, worsted weight yarn.
Main Color: approx. 264 yards
Contrast Color: approx. 10 yards
White: 80 yards

STITCHES: Stockinette and Rib

NOTIONS: Knit hook, crochet hook, sewing needle

GAUGE: 14 stitches and 12 rows = 3"

SIZE: Hat: 22" x 10" Scarf: 4" wide x 50" long.

INSTRUCTIONS

HAT

In main color, cast on all 60 pegs with basic Stockinette stitch working in the round in double knit, lay anchor yarn in contrast color.

Rows 1-5: Rib stitch

Row 6: Stockinette stitch

Cut main color, tie on contrast color.

Row 7: Stockinette stitch

Cut contrast color, tie on white.

Rows 8-17: Stockinette stitch

Cut white, tie on contrast color.

Row 18: Stockinette stitch

Cut contrast color, tie on main color.

Rows 19-33: Stockinette stitch

Move the inner loom loops to the outer loom. The inner loom will be empty and the outer loom will have 2 loops on each peg. Lift the bottom loops over the top loops so there are only just 1 loop on each of the pegs. Remove the inner loom topper.

The remainder of the hat will be worked in single knit.

Rows 34-38: Rib stitch (knit 2, purl 2)

Bind off by using the gather bind off method, weave in all yarn ends. Crochet the cast on edge and remove anchor yarn.





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SCARF

In main color, cast on 19 pegs with basic Stockinette stitch working as a flat panel in double knitting, lay anchor yarn in contrast color.

Rows 1-10: Stockinette stitch

Cut main color, tie on contrast color.

Row 11: Stockinette stitch

Cut contrast color, tie on white.

Rows 12-31: Stockinette stitch

Cut white, tie on contrast color.

Row 32: Stockinette stitch

Cut contrast color, tie on main color.

Rows 33-152: Stockinette stitch

Cut main color, tie on contrast color.

Row 153: Stockinette stitch

Cut contrast color, tie on white.

Rows 154-173: Stockinette stitch

Cut white, tie on contrast color.

Row 174: Stockinette stitch

Cut contrast color, tie on main color.

Rows 175-184: Stockinette stitch

Move the inner loom loops to the outer loom. The inner loom will be empty and the outer loom will have 2 loops on each peg. Lift the bottom loops over the top loops so there are

only just 1 loop on each of the pegs. Crochet the loops off in chain fashion. Crochet the cast on edge and remove anchor yarn. Weave in all yarn ends.
