



Frosted Ridge Mittens/Hat Set

What better way to stay cozy this winter than with a super chunky mittens & hat set that feels as soft as clouds, toasty warm, and works up in a jiffy with the Zippy Looms!



LOOM: (6) Zippy Looms + (4) Zippy Corners
Samples uses 28 pegs.

YARN: Approx. 165 yards super bulky yarn.
Sample used approx. 1 skein for mittens and
2 skeins for hat of Lion Brand Color Clouds, 55
yds, 100% acrylic, in Fortune Teller's (Teal)

NOTIONS: Loom tool, yarn needle, large
removable stitch marker

GAUGE: 5.5 sts x 10 rows = 4 inches in
stockinette

SIZE: Teen / Adult.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx=approximately
k=knit stitch (note: the U-stitch was used for
project).

CO=cast on

BO=bind off

KO=knit off

WY=working yarn

st(s)=stitch(es)

rnd(s)=round(s)

PATTERN NOTES

All knits are worked as U-Stitches.

It is a good idea to work a gauge swatch using
just the knit stitch/U-stitch and compare to the
gauge listed for the sample. This will help in





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achieving the appropriate wrapping tension for the project, resulting in the size desired.

INSTRUCTIONS

MITTENS

CO to all 13 pegs to work as a flat panel.
(sample used Chain CO)

Rows 1-6: *k1, p1, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 7: p13.

Rows 8-11: k13.

Row 12: (Thumb Row)

- pegs 1-5: k,
- pegs 6-8: without cutting yarn, k 15 rows panel knit on these 3 pegs only to form a long strip,
- pegs 9-13: without cutting yarn, continue with the rest of the row: k.

Row 13: p13.

Rows 14-18: k13.

Row 19: p13.

Fingertips

*Move 1st 2 sts of current row inward toward work by 1 peg each. New 2nd peg will now have 2 loops. Knit row, and KO 2nd peg 2 loops over 1.

Repeat from * 4 additional times, alternating sides for decrease. 8 pegs will remain with loops.

Gather BO 8 pegs. Leave a 30" tail for invisibly seaming the sides of the mitten together.

Add new 20" length of yarn to seam up sides of thumb and any sts that may need tightened in those areas.

Weave in all ends and trim close to work.

HAT



BRIM

For an interesting vertical garter brim (shown on sample...see *note below for an alternate option.) CO to only 4 pegs and knit 54 Rows in the following pattern:

- Row a: s1, k3
- Row b: s1, p2, k1

Take this long strip and place across the inside of 28 pegs on a Zippy Loom configured in the round. Place front "leg" of each slipped chain along edge of long strip onto each peg. Strip will be stretched around the inside of the loom.





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Place a removable stitch marker on the WY after the last purl stitch sewn through.

Thread through all the knit stitches and remove hat from loom.

Completely cinch in all purl sts before marker. Now cinch in all knit sts after marker, while keeping purl sts cinched tight.

Carefully remove marker and completely cinch all the knit sts, removing any slack from yarn.

Pull end to inside of hat and knot securely.

Add pom pom if desired.

Weave in all ends and trim close to work.

Prepare to work in the round. Leave an 8" tail for seaming up the CO and BO edges of strip together later.

**Note: an alternate brim style to the one listed above is to simply work 6 rounds of: *k1, p1, rep from * to end of round.*

***Rounds 1-3:** k28.

Round 4: p28.

Rounds 5-12: Repeat from * 2 additional times.

Rounds 13-16: *k2, p2, rep from * to end of round.

FINISHING

Wrap WY around loom 1.5 times and cut at this point.

Thread yarn tail through all the purl stitches and remove them from the loom.
