

# Metropolitan Cowl

Make a cowl in less than 1 hour! The organic nature of the seed stitch provides this cowl an urban feel full of texture and life.



**Knitting Loom:** (2) Zippy looms, 8 pegs needed

**Yarn:** 40 yards of Mega Bulky acrylic yarn. Sample used Bernat Mega Bulky (1 skein in Claret color)

**Stitches:** Knit Stitch/U Stitch, purl

**Notions:** Knitting tool, big eye tapestry needle. (1) accent button (2 inches in diameter)

**Size:** 6 inches wide x 20 inches long

**Gauge:** 5 sts x 9 rows= 4 inches



# Instructions

Leave a 12" yarn tail; Ewrap cast on 8 pegs from left to right.

**Row 1:** \*knit 1 peg, purl 1 peg; rep from \* to the end of row.

Rep Row 1 until item measures approximately 19 inches from cast on edge.

Bind off loosely with basic bind off method.

**Finishing:** Overlap the cast on edge to the bind off edge (about 1.5"). Sew the button in place, sewing through both layers of the knitted item.

Weave all ends in. Tighten the cast on edge for a neat, finished look.
