



Hoppies Socks



LOOM: KB 'Rotating' Double Knit Loom, used as a single knitting, outside rail only.

YARN: Sample used Stitch Studio Earthtone in Cream approx 100 yards.

NOTIONS: Tapestry needle, accent buttons.

GAUGE: 6 stitches and 8 rows to 1" of flat stitch.

SIZE: Medium 7-8, large 8-9.

These house socks are easy to knit. Using only the flat stitch and purl stitch, these are great for any skill level.

ABBREVIATIONS

K= uwrap stitch/flat stitch

P= purl stitch

INSTRUCTIONS

Work one clockwise and one counter clockwise.

Ewrap cast on 52 pegs, prepare to work in the round.

Cuff:

Row 1: k3 (p1, k4) p1, k3

Row 2: (k2, p1, k1, p1) k2

Repeat rows 1&2 for a total of 30 rows.

Rows 31-35: k row

Heel:

Turn heel on 26 pegs, using short row shaping. There will be 10 unwrapped pegs when finished decreasing.

Foot:

Knit in flat stitch for a total of 35 (40) rows. Work as many rows as desired for the length of the sock. (8 rows = 1")

Toe:

Repeat heel instructions for toe.

Bind off and slip last loop off peg and cut yarn leaving an 12" tail for sewing.

Sew the toe closed using a yarn needle using the Invisible Stitch.

Tighten cast on edge.

Sew on accent buttons to the cuff. (The set of 4 knit stitches side by side)
