



# Quick Knit Cowl Vest

One simple pattern, but 2 completely different looks. Just change up the yarn and loom size to create a hip, trendy, short vest, or a longer, fuller elegant vest. Your choice! Either way a FUN SIMPLE pattern.



**LOOM:** 'Premium' Chunky Round Looms, 36 and 48 pegs.

**YARN:** Small, 348 yds. Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Tonal, 4 skeins. Large, 540 yds. Red Heart Vera in Pietra, 4 skeins.

**NOTIONS:** Knit hook, crochet hook, tapestry needle.

**GAUGE:** sm/m: 9sts x 10 rows = 4" Lg/XL: 11sts x 15 rows = 4"

**SIZE:** sm/m: 15" x 19" Lg/XL: 18" x 22"

## NOTES

Pattern is worked as a flat panel. The front and back are made in two separate pieces, both the same. Then sewn together leaving a large opening for the arms. Vest is then flipped inside out, purl stitch on the outside. The knit side is on the inside of vest.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### SHORT BLUE VEST

Small size (36 peg loom)

#### Front/ Back (make 2)

Ewrap cast on 36 pegs, prepare to work as a flat panel.

**Row 1:** Purl to end of row.

**Row 2:** Ewrap knit to end of row.

Repeat rows 1 & 2, 14 times (28 rows)

**Next 49 rows:** Ewrap knit to end of row.

Repeat row 1 and 2, 14 times (28 rows)

**Next row:** Purl to end of row.

### LONG GRAY VEST

Large size (48 peg loom)

#### Front/ Back (make 2)

Ewrap cast on 48 pegs, prepare to work as a flat panel.

**Row 1:** Purl to end of row

**Row 2:** Ewrap knit to end of row.

Repeat rows 1 & 2, 23 times (46 rows)

**Next 53 rows:** Ewrap to end of row.

Repeat row 1 and 2, 23 times (46 rows).

**Next row:** Purl to end of row.





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Bind off using the basic bind off method leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

### **FINISHING FOR BOTH SIZES**

At the cast on edge, use the yarn tails to sew the sides together with mattress stitch. End sewing at garter edging.



Then at the bind off edge, use the yarn tail to sew the sides to create the cowl section. Make sure to leave an 11" opening on each side for arm holes.

Weave in ends. Turn vest inside out featuring the purl side.
