



Toddler Tunic



LOOM: KB 'Premium' Round Loom Set (orange loom)

YARN: 540 yds of worsted weight merino wool. Knit Picks Tonal was used in sample, color Boysenberry (2 skeins).

NOTIONS: Tapestry needle, row counter (optional), stitch markers (2).

OTHER: 4 decorative buttons.

GAUGE: 11 sts x 15 rows = 2".

SIZE: 12-24 months (2T-3T).

pertain to both sizes. Instructions in () pertain to size 2T-3T). Block Front and Back panels before assembly.

Front side: place stitch markers on peg 51 (59) and peg 60 (68). Lace stitch pattern takes place over those 10 pegs.

Tip: For the lace stitch pattern, view the Wheat Eyelets video and follow the first 8 rows of the Flat Panel version.

ABBREVIATIONS

K=knit stitch
P=purl stitch
St(s)=stitch(es)
Rnd(s)=Round(s)
Rep=repeat
Yo=yarn over
K2tog=knit two together, slants to right
Ssk=slip, slip knit, slants to left.
Sl=slip (skip the peg with yarn behind the peg)

NOTES

Two sizes provided: 12-24m and 2T-3T. When only one set of instructions is given, instructions

INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

Cast on 72 (80) sts, prepare to work a flat panel.

Row 1, 3, 5, 7, 9: sl 1, k to end of row.

Row 2, 4, 6, 8, 10: sl 1, p to last peg, k1.

Row 11: sl 1, k to end of row.

Row 12: sl 1, p5, k to last 6 pegs, p5, k1.

Repeat Rows 11 and 12 until you reach Row 120 (140).

Bind off with basic bind off method.

Weave in all ends.

Block.

Add 2 decorative buttons to each side, joining the front to the back.

FRONT

Cast on 72 (80) sts, prepare to work a flat panel.

Row 1, 3, 5, 7, 9: sl 1, k to end of row.

Row 2, 4, 6, 8, 10: sl 1, p to last peg, k1.

Row 11: sl 1, k to peg 50 (58), k1, yo, k2, ssk, k1, k2tog, k2, yo, k to end of row.

Row 12: sl 1, p5, k to last 6 pegs, p5, k1.

Repeat Rows 11 and 12 until you reach Row 138.

Next row: sl 1, k to end of row.

Next row: sl 1, p5, k to last 6 sts, p5, k1.

Bind off with basic bind off method.

Block.

NECK COWL

Cast on 68 (72) sts, prepare to work a flat panel.

Row 1-12: *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 13: p to end of row.

Next 12 rows: *p2, k2; rep from * to end.

ASSEMBLY

Mattress stitch seam at the shoulders, approximately 3.5 (4) inches in on the left side, and the right side.

Using the mattress stitch, join the Collar to the body of the Poncho.
