



Jazz Cowl



LOOM: (4) Zippy Looms, (4) Corners

YARN: Premier Couture Jazz yarn, 2 skeins, approx. 32 yds.

NOTIONS: Knitting tool, crochet hook to weave in ends, scissors.

GAUGE: 3.25 sts x 6 rows = 4".

Time to knit: 30 minutes

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 20 sts in ewrap and prepare to work in the round.

Row 1: Ewrap knit to end.

Repeat Row 1, until 30" of yarn remain of 2nd skein of yarn.

Bind off with Basic Bind off method.

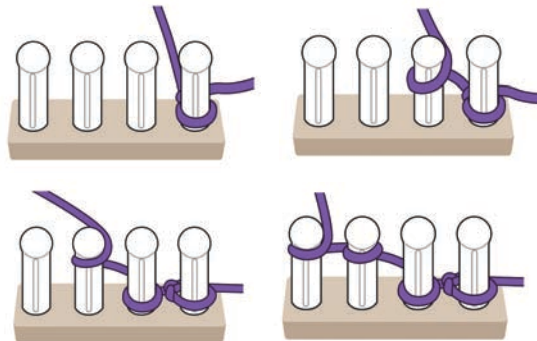
Weave ends in.

HOW-TO

Cast On [\(Cast On video\)](#)

Place the slipknot on the first peg on the right side of the Zippy loom.

Moving from right to left around the loom, wrap the working yarn around 2nd peg in counterclockwise direction. Repeat with the remaining pegs.

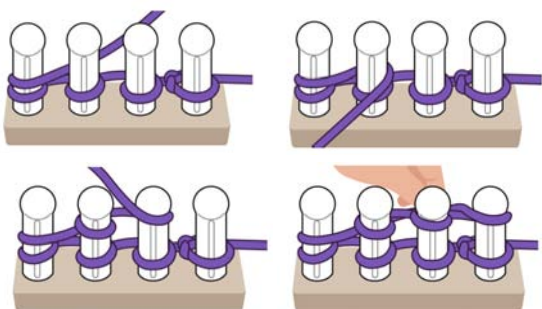




Ewrap Stitch ([Ewrap Stitch Video](#))

Continue wrapping in the same direction around the loom, wrapping each peg again. Once you reach the last peg and each peg has 2 loops you are ready to knit over stitches.

Note: Working around the loom one time is called a “round”.



Starting with the last peg (where the working yarn is located), with your fingers (or knitting hook) take the bottom loop up and over/off the peg. Repeat with the remaining pegs. One loop should remain on each peg.
